The FDA/Industry/Academia fellowship program provides Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) graduates training in one of three tracks focused on drug information, medication safety, or advertising and promotion. The program serves to maintain and enhance a link among the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA), academia, and the pharmaceutical industry. Graduates will be qualified to pursue career opportunities in all three areas.

The Takeda-Purdue Fellowships will provide Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) graduates with the opportunity to gain specialized, hands-on training and experience in Global Regulatory Affairs, Clinical Operations, or Medical Affairs. In addition to bolstering a scientific link between Takeda and Purdue University, the fellowship aims to enhance the regulatory, medical, and clinical operations activities at Takeda, with a goal to eventually serve and improve the drug development process across the industry.
