# PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Memorial Medical Center Modesto

### About the Program:

Sutter Memorial Medical Center is a 419-bed general acute care center located in Modesto, CA. This program offers residents exposure to a variety of practice environments and experiences across the continuum of care including acute, transitional and ambulatory care settings in a not-for-profit health system.

### Program Purpose:

PGY1 residency programs build upon Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) education and outcomes to develop pharmacist practitioners with knowledge, skills, and abilities as defined in the educational competency areas, goals, and objectives. Residents who successfully complete PGY1 residency programs will be skilled in diverse patient care, practice management, leadership, and education, and be prepared to provide patient care, seek board certification in pharmacotherapy (i.e., BCPS), and pursue advanced education and training opportunities including postgraduate year two (PGY2) residencies.

### Program Details:

This program provides residents with the opportunity to strengthen and solidify their clinical skills. There will be required core rotations with elective rotations as listed below. Longitudinal rotations in research and pharmacy operations will also be required to further develop residents' skill sets.
