

# Residency Application Timeline

-Identify 3 individuals to prepare a letter of recommendation on your behalf.

-Search for ASHP accredited residency training programs

-Consider accessing additional resources to help you prepare for your residency interview.

**August (or earlier)**

-Register to attend the ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting (MCM)

-Select programs to visit in the MCM Residency Showcase

-Consider registering for Personnel Placement Service (PPS)

-Plan travel and housing arrangements

**October**

-Attend the ASHP Midyear Clinical Meeting

-Check Residency Programs application requirements and deadline

-Send all the necessary documents in to PhORCAS

-Submit PhORCAS applications

-Programs contact applicants for on-site interviews.

**December**

-Complete interviews

-Narrow Residency choices to programs that best meet your professional/personal needs and goals.

-Review instructions for submitting Rank Order Lists and obtaining Match Results

-Begin ranking programs

**February**

- Most residencies begin

**July**

**September**

-Begin updating/fine-tuning your CV-take advantage of ASHP CV review program

-Begin working on cover letters/letters of intent.

-Begin asking for letters of recommendation

**November**

-Review information about the Match

-Access a list of programs participating in the Match.

-Register for PhORCAS and the Match.

-Finalize your CV and cover letters

-Requests transcript to be sent to PhORCAS

**January**

- On-site interviews begin

**March**

-Submit Rank Order List by the date published by national matching services Inc.

-Receive "Match" outcome at noon Easter Daylight Savings Time on the published date.

-Unmatched residency candidates can utilize PhORCAS to search for, and apply to, programs still seeking candidates.

-Begin applying for licensure in the state of your residency
