ABOUT THE PROGRAM

- The UI College of Pharmacy boasts the longest continually-accredited PGY1 Community-based Pharmacy Residency Program. This program has five unique practice sites and candidates can select sites that best fit their interests.
- Community Pharmacy Residents spend 2/3 of their time provide patient care services in the community pharmacy or other ambulatory care settings, such as community health centers and free medical clinics.
 - Community-based sites are members of CPESN-IA and CPESN-USA, a clinically integrated network of community pharmacies, and provide clinical medication synchronization, adherence packaging, immunizations, comprehensive medication reviews with chronic care management, medication reconciliation, enhanced MTM and other patient care programs.
 - Pharmacy sites, preceptors, & faculty are participating in the National **Flip the Pharmacy** Project (<https://www.flipthepharmacy.com/>) to transform Community Pharmacy Practice in Iowa and beyond.
- Residents participate in the Pharmacy Educator Preparation Program for Residents (PEPPR) to learn teaching philosophy and techniques and can apply those skills in educating Doctor of Pharmacy students, other health care providers, and patients.
- Residents complete a practice-based research project with the guidance of UI College of Pharmacy Health Service Research Faculty and participate in a peer review writing group with other community residents.
- Preceptors in the Community Pharmacy Residency Program are recognized as leaders in the profession of pharmacy both on a state and national level. Many are highly decorated for their dedication to and innovation in community pharmacy practice.
- Residency program graduates have gone onto clinical practice in community, clinic, and other settings, PGY2 Ambulatory Care positions, academia, ownership and other unique opportunities.

COMMUNITY PHARMACY RESIDENCY SITES

HyVee Pharmacy, Iowa City
